Modale Hilfsverben und ihre Ersatzformen

	simple present	simple past
Eine Fähigkeit ausdrücken can = be able to	Kim can speak English. Kim is able to speak English. Are you able to speak French?	Kim could speak English. Kim was able to speak English. Were you able to speak French?
Eine Erlaubnis/ein Verbot ausdrücken can = be allowed to	I can't use my mobile. I am (I'm)not allowed to use my mobile at school. Are you allowed to do that?	I couldn't use my mobile. I was not (wasn't) allowed to use my mobile. Were you allowed to do that?
Eine Verpflichtung ausdrücken must = have to	Lucy must take History. We don't have to take Journalism. Must you take Science?	Lucy had to take History. We didn't have to take Journalism. Did you have to take Science?
